

Our Keynote Speaker



Bana Jabri, MD, PhD is the Sarah and Harold Lincoln Thompson Distinguished Service Professor of Medicine at the University of Chicago. She is the Research Director of the Celiac Disease Center at the University. Her research focuses on innate and mucosal immunity, particularly in autoimmune disorders, celiac disease, and inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). She also works on the mechanisms of celiac disease, new

treatment options as well as the effect of the microbiome on immune responses.

Dr. Jabri was the first researcher in the United States to win the William K. Warren Jr. Prize for Excellence in Celiac Disease Research in 2009. Among her long list of awards and honors is the Lloyd Mayer Prize in Mucosal Immunology that she received in 2017. She is an elected member of the Association of American Physicians and publishes high impact science in journals such as Nature, Science, Nature Medicine, Gastroenterology, the New England Journal of Medicine, and Cell. She is passionate about teaching and is a recipient of the Llewellyn John & Harriet Manchester Quantrell Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Education.
